PreCanskate is designed for the youngest and/or newest beginners who may be trying out skating for the very first time and are unsteady on their skates. The program focuses on fun, participation and basic skill development. The participants will earn badges and other incentives as they learn fundamental skating skills.

CanSkate is where steadier skaters gain speed and confidence in skills learned either independently or in PreCan. Typically skaters are 5 before entering this level but younger skaters may participate. CanSkate is a continuation of Canada's flagship learn-to-skate program, designed for beginners of all ages. Our program focuses on extending the basic skills relevant to hockey, figure, and speed skating. The participants will earn badges and other incentives as they learn fundamental skating skills.

Jr StarSkate program is the level where skater focus more on fundamental <u>figure skating skills</u> involving foot work, spins, and jumps that are encompassed within ice dance, skills, free skate elements and interpretive skating. This program teaches figure skating in a group lesson format in a progressive and sequential manner. Skaters have the opportunity to participate in group performances that, at coaches discretion, may vary in size.

Sr StarSkate builds on skills begun in Jr Star, with a combination of group lesson and independent learning time. Skills are developed in a progressive and sequential manner.

Skaters have the opportunity to complete Skate Canada tests on home ice through the nationally standardized testing system. Tests begin in each of the three core areas (Skills, Freeskate, & Dance) and progress to more variety at higher levels. Skaters are encouraged to participate in club performances, with the option to express their personal creativity through choreography. There are also typically 1-2 opportunities per full year to compete in a regional competition.
